Governance Training for Women

to be held in Puvirnituaq in May 2010.

The 4-day training will focus on women in leadership roles in Nunavik's social and government organizations. It will explore opportunities for women to take responsible positions in municipal and regional governments. It will look at governance in non-government organizations and on Boards — how they function, how they can be effective, how they can be influential. Training will include looking at budgets and financial statements, as well as leadership models, dealing with the media and ethics in public office.

Inuit women with experience in governance will talk about their positions, their challenges, will discuss mentoring, how to handle influence and power, and will comment on issues of equality amongst women and men.

Training sessions will be personal and relevant to Nunavik women.

There are places for two women from each community to attend. The sessions will be of interest to women on Boards of Directors, Municipal Councils, other local and regional committees. However, this is not a requirement. All women who are interested in governance and leadership development are invited to submit their name for registration. If you know of women in your community who would benefit from the training, please recommend the session to them.
